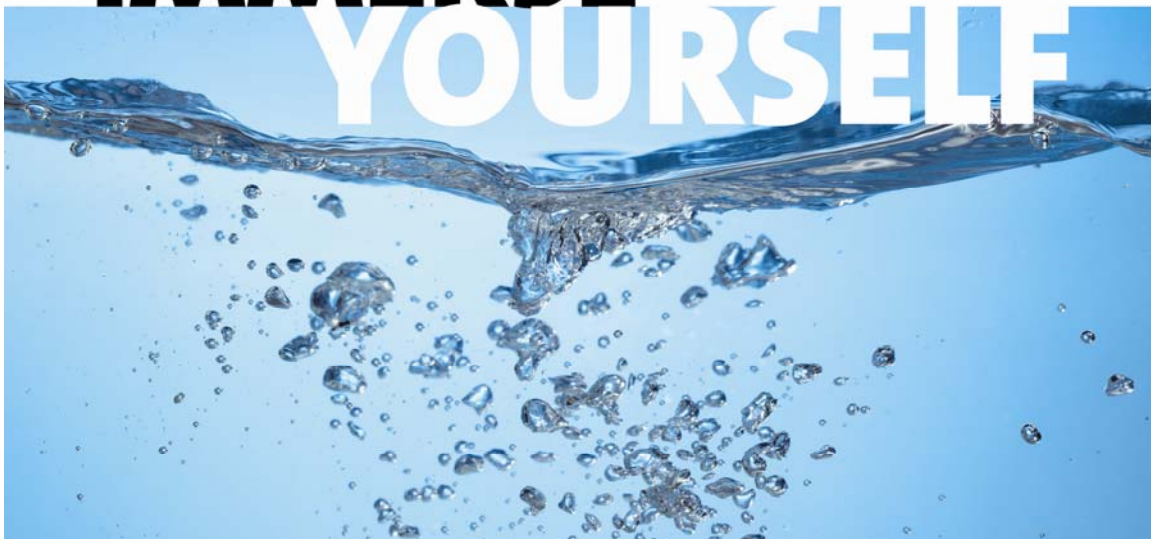

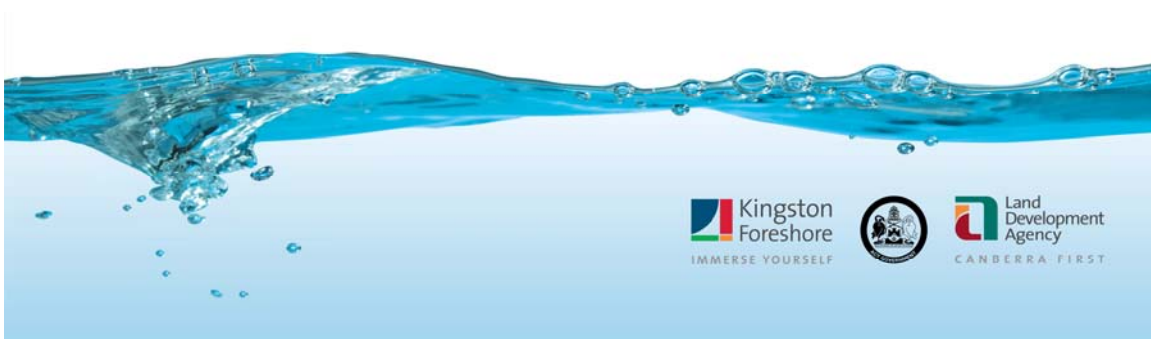
## LDA wins National Award

## The harbour life takes shape

Canberra Investment Corporation Limited (CIC) has unveiled designs for its Quayside Harbour apartment complex at Kingston Foreshore. Ninety-six apartments are being designed stretching between Eyre and Giles Streets along Eastlake Parade. At street level, more than 2,000 square metres of commercial space is planned that will be split over two levels for office, retail, restaurants and cafes. Up above, there are five levels of varied living options. The development is expected to be completed in about 18 months.
